

Chancel Choir - The Chancel Choir is a volunteer group that leads the 11:00 a.m. congregation in a more traditional, blended style of worship. Rehearsals are Wednesday nights from 6:00 - 7:00 p.m. in the Choir Room. Membership is open to all singers high school age and above, regardless of choral experience. New singers are always welcome. Daybreak - Daybreak is volunteer group comprised of instrumentalists and singers that lead the Praise and Worship Music during the more contemporary and less formal 8:45 a.m. service. Their more non-traditional musical style ranges from Contemporary Christian to Christian Country. Daybreak membership is open to any Christian musician who would like to use his/her gift for the Lord. Rehearsals are on Thursday nights from 7:00 - 8:00 p.m. New talent is always welcome. Hand Bells - This all-volunteer group provides worshipful melodies at special times of the year. The group practices on Thursday evenings at 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. in the Hand Bell Room.

Media - Another area of music ministry for the church includes the sound board and visual displays. Volunteers are always needed to help perfect the audio and visual presentations for the Sunday worship services and special events.

The Columbus Community Choir - Sponsored by the First United Methodist Church of Columbus, the Columbus Community Choir is made up of volunteers from throughout the county who provide special choral music performances at Easter, Christmas, and other special occasions. Rehearsals are held on Monday evenings for several weeks prior to each performance. Contributions from the concerts and from the members themselves, allows the choir to pay for its music, costumes, travel, risers and all other props. Community performances are held at the Columbus High School Auditorium.
