

Blood Drive - A blood drive is held the fourth Friday of every month in the Family Life Center. The Gulf Coast Regional Blood Center sends a staff to service donors. Consider being a blood donor.

UMCOR - Periodically, the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) makes requests for needs in times of crisis including floods, natural disasters, relocation issues, etc. These needs may be monetary or material, as in cleaning/health kits (aka: Flood Buckets), school kits, etc. UMCOR is always looking for volunteers. Hospitality Committee - This group of volunteers works together on special receptions for the church.

Senior Care Ministry - We visit the various senior homes once a month to sing hymns and share a devotional and Communion with the residents. We would love to have you join us in this celebration.

Food Pantry - The Columbus Food Pantry Inc. is sponsored by the local Ministerial Alliance of churches and our Family Life Center serves as the distribution point. The local Food Pantry serves approximately 250 households or 800 individuals within Columbus and the surrounding area. Groceries are delivered from the Golden Crescent Food Bank in Victoria, TX on the third Thursday of each month. Volunteers are rotated from various churches through the Ministerial Alliance of churches to assist with the unloading of groceries and sacking process. Approximately 300 sacks of groceries are distributed to recipients the third Friday of each month. Volunteers are always needed to help with this service.

Share Your Christmas (SYC) - Share Your Christmas is a church-sponsored ministry to share Christ's love and light to families in Columbus, Glidden and Alleyton during the Advent season. Joint efforts of the SYC Committee and the congregation provide needy families with gifts, groceries, linens, and toiletries for Christmas. The SYC Committee is responsible for fundraising, collecting toiletries, linens and groceries, reviewing applications, and preparing and organizing the distribution by angel families. The SYC Committee is made up of women and men of all ages.



Jimmie Faye Schilling Memorial Sock Tree - The Sock Tree was started after church members Jimmie Faye and L. D. Schilling adopted their son from the Methodist Mission Home in Waco. Each September Jimmie Faye collected socks of all sizes for children at the Methodist Mission Homes. After her death the Outreach Committee continued this ministry in her memory. The congregation donates socks every September which are then mailed to Methodist Mission Homes.

Thanksgiving Dinner - This outreach project provides the community a free Thanksgiving meal with all the trimmings. All in the community who lack resources or immediate family in the area and wish to have a Thanksgiving meal are welcome. We solicit and receive donations from the congregation and always need volunteers to help set-up, serve and clean-up. This fund raising effort begins in September.
