

UM ARMY - United Methodist Action Reach-out Mission by Youth. The mission of the UM Army is to provide Christ-centered, quality, youth work camps that serve people in need and promote spiritual growth and leadership development in the Youth. This is a God-led, volunteer, youth-focused organization that gives youth the opportunity to experience Christian growth through mission, worship, and fellowship. It is a weeklong camp in which participants combine their strengths to meet home repair and maintenance needs for low income, elderly and disabled homeowners who are physically or financially unable to make needed repairs themselves. The youth must be in junior or senior high school. Adults are also encouraged to attend as guides for the youth. Anyone interested in helping with UM Army, contact the church office.

United Methodist Men (UMM) - The United Methodist Men is a men's group that meets the third Tuesday of each month, September through May. These meetings begin at 6:00 p.m. for fellowship, a devotion/program, and concluding with a short business meeting. They host the annual church Christmas Dinner and other socials during the year. They also complete special projects for either the church or charitable groups. All men of the church are welcome and encouraged to join the Methodist Men and participate in their activities.

United Methodist Women (UMW) - The United Methodist Women is a women's group involved in activity and study of Methodist Mission service. The women meet the second Sunday of each month in February, May, September, and November. All women of the church are welcome and encouraged to join UMW and participate in their activities.

Bereavement Committee - This group of volunteers provides a light meal for families following a funeral or memorial service. Whether you are involved in preparing food, setting-up, and/or serving, volunteers are always needed, welcomed, and very much appreciated by the committee and the bereaved family.

Emmaus - The Walk to Emmaus is a spiritual renewal program intended to strengthen the local church through the development of Christian disciples and leaders. The Walk to Emmaus experience begins with a 72-hour retreat focusing on the themes of God's grace, disciplines of Christian discipleship, and what it means to be in the church. The three-day Emmaus experience and follow-up groups strengthen and renew Christian people as disciples of Jesus Christ and as active members of the body of Christ in mission to the world. There is no longer a local Emmaus community, however if you would like to go on a retreat or to send someone on a reatreat, we can set that up for you.

Kairos - The mission of the Kairos Prison Ministry is to bring Christ's love and forgiveness to all incarcerated individuals, their families and those who work with them, and to assist in the transition of becoming a productive citizen. Kairos encourages believers from a variety of Christian traditions to be volunteers in this Christ-filled ministry. Kairos offers the opportunity to receive God's forgiveness through faith in Jesus Christ, and to grow in faith and servant hood in Christian community.
